The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on: 03/04/2019, and investigated by Kathy Geringer

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

Reported Allegation:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 8. Health and Sanitation

Section 4. Sanitation Requirements for Child Care Facilities

(b) All Family Child Care Homes (FCCH) and Family Child Care Centers (FCCC) shall comply with the following standards. The principles and requirements of the Wyoming Food Safety Rule may be required, over and above these rules, in cases where potentially hazardous foods are prepared.

(xxv) Miscellaneous

(F) Toys and other small articles that may find their way into children's mouths shall be cleaned and sanitized at least once a week or whenever visibly soiled by using an approved sanitizer at the proper strength.

Reason: A report has been received that toys are not being cleaned and sanitized at least once a week.

Explanation of Findings: This investigation has shown that in two classrooms the toys are being cleaned and sanitized properly to meet Licensing requirements. In the preschool academy classroom the toys are being sanitized daily but in the case of the small manipulative, multi-surface toys, the total cleaning had been occurring every other week, instead of weekly for at least January and February of 2019. This had resulted in a finding of non-compliance.

Compliance Action Required: Please submit a Corrective Action Plan that demonstrates what procedures have been implemented to ensure that the small multi-surface toys are being cleaned weekly to ensure every contact surface, has been cleaned and sanitized.

2. Finding: Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 8. Health and Sanitation
Section 5. Health Requirements for all Child Care Facilities

(a) Communicable diseases

(iv) Exclusion of children:

(F) When communicable diseases occur and attendees or other staff have been exposed, all staff members shall be advised and all parents or guardians of exposed children shall be immediately notified by the provider to observe for symptoms; the specific identity of the persons infected with a communicable disease shall not be revealed except to authorized health authorities.

Reason: An allegation has been received that parents are not adequately notified of parents being notified of communicable diseases diagnosed in children who are attending the center.

Explanation of Findings: This investigation has shown that parents are being notified of communicable diseases as is required by Licensing rules. The result of the investigation is a finding of compliance.
